School uniform expectations

Dear Parents and Carers,

Across the federation, we have high expectations for our pupils and we aim to foster a sense of pride among the school community. This is reflected in our expectations for school uniform. As we begin to think about the new school year, we would like to take the opportunity to share the school uniform requirements.

Uniform

- Grey or black smart trousers, skirt or long tailored shorts
- White polo shirt. This can be plain or have a school logo.
- Blue and white gingham school dresses
- Royal blue sweatshirt. This can be plain or have a school logo.
- Completely black school shoes with a low heel. Not trainers or open toed shoes. Black ankle boots are allowed in the winter months.
- Watches or stud earrings are the only jewellery permitted. Earrings should be removed or covered for PE.
- Long hair should be tied back with a discreet hairband. No big or novelty hairbands, no big bows or cat ears.

PE kit

Children are required to come to school in their kit on PE days.

- Navy blue or black shorts
- House colour t-shirt for Year 4, 5 and 6/ a white t shirt for Year R, 1, 2 and 3.
- Trainers with grip on the bottom which are suitable for outdoors sport in the winter months.
- Plimsolls are not required for PE
- Navy blue or black tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue or black plain sweatshirt or hoodie.

Equipment

- Water bottle (no glass bottles)
- A small bag to contain a lunchbox, book and water bottle. A small navy blue or black draw string bag would be preferable. All other equipment is provided by the school. Reminder- pencil cases are NOT needed.

Please label all clothes and personal items clearly with your child's name in indelible ink.

We do have some pre-loved uniform available at no cost. This will be brought out onto the playground regularly should children need any uniform. Alternatively, please contact Mrs Pink, our parent support advisor, who can collect a few items to send home with your child.
